Training: All Workforce	\$15,000 to \$150,000	Regional training offering with no degree/licensure requirement for completion/certification, <u>e.g.</u> Mental Health First Aid, Motivational Interviewing, topics/issues of interest		
Training: Master's/Clinical	\$3,000 to \$100,000	Regional training offering of EBP(s) with degree/licensure requirements for completion and certification, <u>e.g.</u> PCIT, CBT+, etc. Would need to identify specific EBPs desired by a critical mass of orgs		
Training: Scholarships	\$25,000 to \$150,000	Scholarships for individual practitioners to attend relevant trainings in order to pursue proficiency, certification		
Training: Train the Trainer	\$10,000 to \$100,000	Build local capacity to regularly deliver trainings. For example: MH First Aid (instructor training \$3K/person), EBPs that have Train the Trainer options and are of ongoing regional interest
