I also worked with elder populations at Home and Community Services for 4 years. I am a strong advocate of social justice and have been involved in numerous initiatives, boards and work to improve the lives of our most disenfranchised members. I approach supervision as a collaborative effort. My focus includes case presentations to determine diagnosis, obtaining a good working knowledge of DSM5, and discussion of best treatment practices. I also stress professional ethics and working in a holistic manner that addresses the entire individual. I also address diversity, systemic change, social justice and recent research. Supervisees will be encouraged to become involved in community issues that promote a more just society.</p>
