
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# What is Health Equity?

#### **Equity**

(this is the concept of "affirmative action"), thus producing equity.

#### **Justice**




All 3 can see the game without supports or accommodations because the cause(s) of the inequity was addressed.

The systemic barrier has been removed.



#### Why Lead with race


